



HOW TO USE THE PROPER NOMENCLATURE WHEN USING THE SPECIFICATION GUIDE:

There are eight segments of information that comprise the specification guide.

1. The first five digits identify the fixture type Michaels' Lighting offers:
P - Pendants, F - Flush Mounts, W - Wall Brackets, E - Exterior, and ADA - Americans Disability Acts.
2. The next two digits identifies the **A** dimension which is represented on the line drawings for all fixtures.
3. The next single digit identifies the light source. All standard product is offered in **F -Florescent or I - Incandescent.**
4. The next three digits represent the line voltage required either, **120v or 277v.**
5. The next two digits represent the diffuser material. All standard offering is available in OP - **Opal Acrylic or FP - Hand Painted Faux Alabaster. Options include, white, honey, beige and amber.**
6. The next two digits indicate the texture of the diffuser. There are three options available, **OE - Outside Etch, IE - Inside Etch, and Ne - No Etch.** The reason for etching the diffuser is to soften the glow of the light source, and eliminate the sheen of the acrylic.
7. The next two digits indicate the available metal finishes of product designs. Michaels' Lighting currently offers the following standard available metal finishes:
CP - CUSTOM PAINT
CF - CUSTOM FINISH
BA - BRUSHED ALUMINUM
BB - BRUSHED BRASS
AB - ANTIQUE BRASS
PB - POLISHED BRASS
PA - POLISHED ALUMINUM
8. This is a prefix that represents your intention to modify the product. By using the letters **MOD** at the beginning of the specification, you can selectively change any portion of the standard offering. This must be accomplished with an authorized representative of the factory to insure the changes required could be properly interpreted, and provided.
